Vejle is the ninth largest city in Denmark with more than 50.000 inhabitants. Vejle county has more than 100.000 inhabitants. The city is located approximately 90 kilometres from Odense. Vejle is best known for its nature and the city is beautifully located at the head of Vejle fjord. There are plenty of viewpoints where you can to enjoy the fantastic scenery. For those who enjoy fishing, this is the place for catching sea trout, cod and eel.

- Web Development: Semester 1 and 2 (this is a top-up and therefore refers to semester 5 and 6)






